The restoration was part work and part treasure trove hunting. Jean and her construction team found historical artifacts and placed them in a display case in the design studio. "It's like having a history museum of the house!" Jenn said. "We found some real treasures when we were restoring this house."

Jenn and her team also found many pieces and layers of history in the home. "We had such a great experience restoring the building and were able to find the original hardwood floors. Clients and people throughout Midway love coming into the store, seeing the history, and seeing what can be done restoring this house to something beautiful."

When deciding on the home's style, residents assumed Jenn would want to make the house look Swiss after many other Midway buildings. Still, her resolve was to restore the building to its original condition, where possible. "I tried to make the exterior reflect what it would have looked like in 1872." To find out what the building originally looked like, she researched the original homeowners, the Epperson family, and found they had 13 children in this house. When she redesigned, she decided to keep the main floor the showcase and designer area, with the upstairs becoming the design offices.

Now painted a beautiful, brilliant yellow, people from town admire the home and its inviting charm. Today, the Epperson descendants can walk through and get a full tour of the restored home. Jenn gives back by opening up her showroom to the family for family reunions.
